## **Graham SLAM Initiative Expands to Support Community Youth**



Until this spring, the majority of youth in Graham SLAM had experienced foster care. Thanks to a generous \$1 million contribution from private donors, we are now expanding our reach to include more youth at our community centers, mental health clinics, and family support services who are seeking similar coaching to achieve their life goals. This year, we will reach 180 more youth to increase SLAM's total to 580 youth!

Since the launch of SLAM in 2014, the impact of this initiative has been profound. Our success at Graham and the success of Fair Futures throughout the city and now elsewhere in the state of New York, have proven what's possible when young adults are surrounded by consistent, caring support and life coaching.

## **Tremont Youth & Family Center Lower Level Grand Opening**

On June 3, we held the grand opening for the newly renovated lower level of our Tremont Youth & Family Center in the Bronx! Children, youth, and families have traditionally come here for family supports, health and wellness services, and SLAM coaching. Following our helpful help™ approach, we renovated the lower level to respond to what youth and families have asked for: a modern, beautiful space with a youth lounge, a kitchen and dining space, and more offerings. We plan to renovate the entire four-floor building in the welcoming style of the lower level to offer more community-focused supports as part of Vision 2029.
